

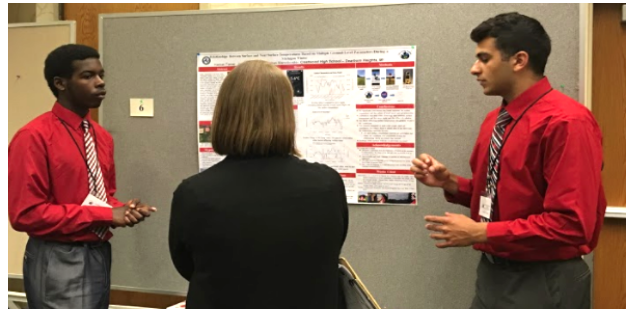
## What is the U.S. GLOBE Regional Student Research Symposium?

At the SRS, students in grades 5 - 12 come together to share results from research investigations using GLOBE protocols and/or the GLOBE database.



During the SRS, students:

- Share their ideas with professional scientists
- Learn from each other
- Receive feedback on their research
- Explore STEM careers



### Why Participate?

- Authentic research experiences lead to students being more engaged in their lessons (Pruneau et al., 2003).
- 2017 Participants' self-efficacy for science tasks increased significantly after the SRS (Gengarely, L. & Solomon, H. (2017) Preliminary Evaluation of United States Regional GLOBE Student Science Symposia. Unpublished data.)
